

What is KidSport?

KidSport helps Western Australian children take part in community sport or swimming lessons by offering up to \$500 towards the cost of joining a KidSport club.

Eligibility criteria

- Aged 5 to 18 years.
- Named on a valid Health Care or Pensioner Concession card issued by Centrelink.
- Resident of Western Australia.



Become a KidSport approved club

Help more families and children experience the benefits of community sport or swimming lessons.

KidSport clubs can:

- redeem vouchers as payment for club fees
- access the online KidSport club portal
- be promoted on the KidSport Find a Club website
- access materials to promote their sport in the community.

How to apply

Applications are open year-round and can be completed online in 3 simple steps.

- 1 Check child eligibility
- 2 Find a KidSport approved club
- 3 Submit an application

Applications will be assessed within 10 working days.

Approved applicants are sent a voucher code. This can be given to a KidSport club to pay registration/membership fees. Your club may also accept vouchers as payment for uniform and equipment costs.



Further information

- Maximum of \$500 per child per financial year can be split over multiple clubs.
- Check your child's eligibility dlgsc.wa.gov.au/kidsport
- If the club fees are more than the approved voucher amount parents will need to pay the difference.
- Vouchers expire after 90 days.
- Clubs will collect the approved voucher during registration at point of payment.

KidSport special considerations

Special consideration applications are available to support identified low-income families who may have difficulty accessing concession cards, or independently applying for a KidSport voucher.

You, or a family you know, may be eligible if they are:

- experiencing significant financial distress (loss of main income source, death/serious illness of main income earner)
- impacted by natural disaster
- child is in formal or informal care (including grandparents or kin)
- an asylum seeker, refugee or other humanitarian entrant.
